During this period, he worked in the offices of San Donato Milanese and Paris, where he also held positions relating to the management of naval assets, engineering and fabrication.

He is currently Chief Supply Chain, Digital and IT Officer of the Saipem Group. In this role, he is responsible for the group's procurement, post-order and logistics, as well as leading the company's digital transformation journey, through the implementation of innovative solutions and the optimization of the group's processes, applications and IT infrastructure.
